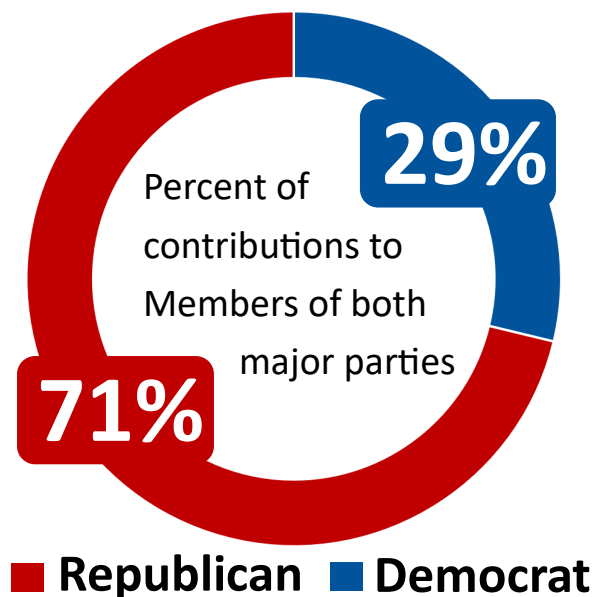
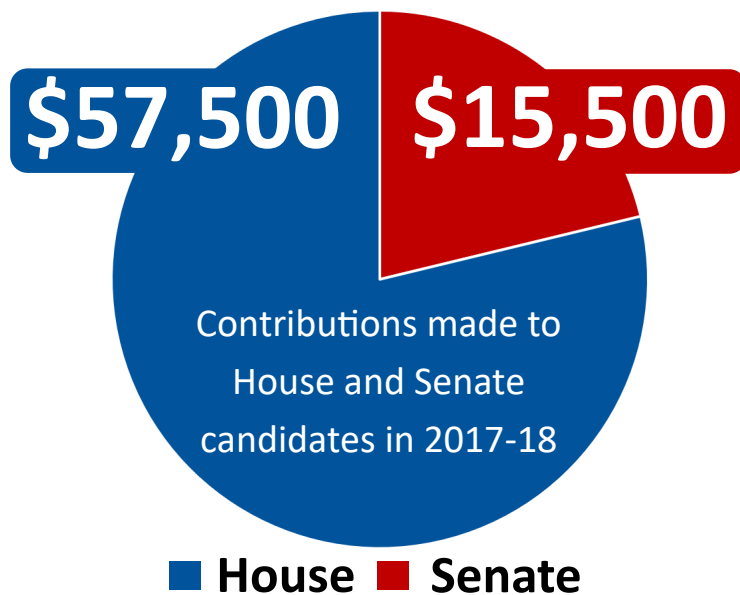




## 2017-18 Progress Report

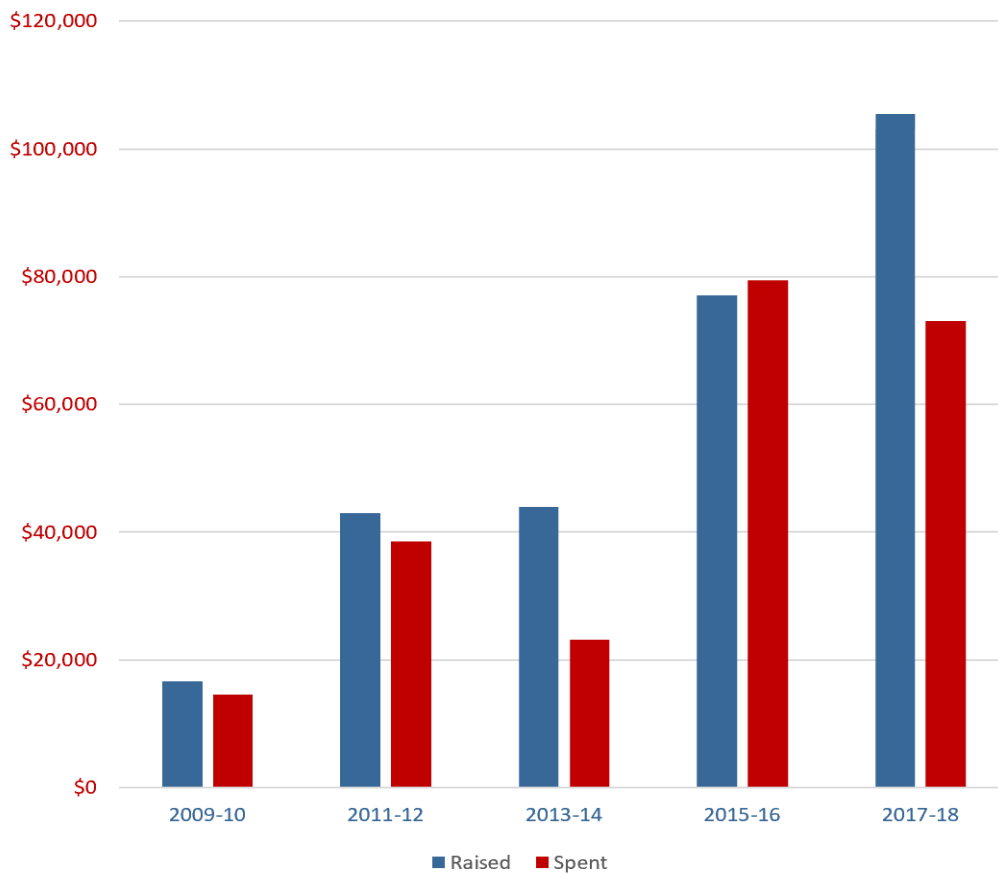
### *By the Numbers...*

**46** Number of individuals who contributed to the PAC in 2017-18

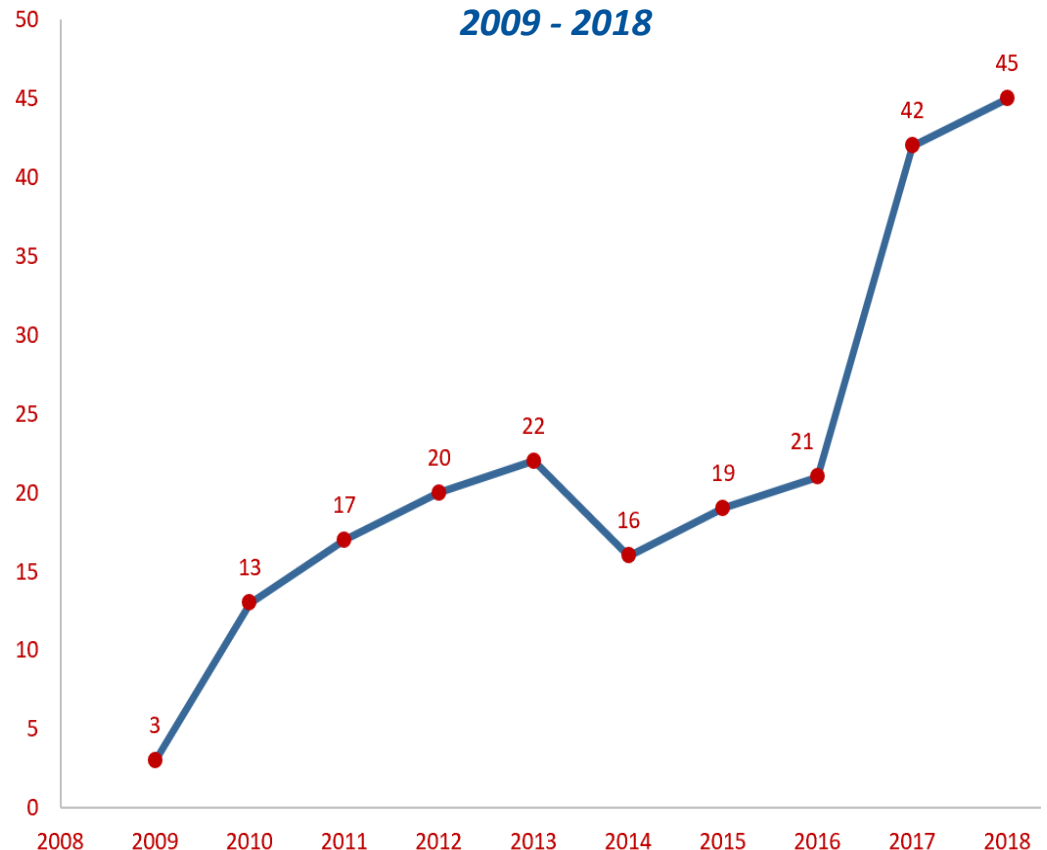
## Contributions Raised and Spent from 2009 - 2018



The IBWA PAC has grown every year since its inception in 2009, surpassing \$105,000 in contributions raised during the 2017-18 campaign cycle. For 2018, the PAC Board set an ambitious goal of raising \$50,000, and IBWA members responded, contributing \$61,900 in 2018 alone.







## IBWA Member Authorization to Solicit Forms Submitted 2009 - 2018

Member corporations giving their authorization to solicit (AtS) is the first step to growing a trade association PAC. The PAC started in 2009 with 3 member companies providing the PAC with AtS, and in 2018, a record high of 45 companies provided the PAC with their authorization to solicit.
